## How the Courses Work Together

- **DPL 1** establishes the **core language, structure, and leadership mindset**
- **DPL 2** builds on that foundation to focus on **analysis, insight generation, and advanced problem-solving**
- Participants may take **DPL 2 without DPL 1** if they already meet the experience expectations, but DPL 1 is strongly recommended for newer panel leaders
